<p><b>MITE</b> (10 &amp; under)</p>	<p>All ages are as of 12/31/09. All open league rosters must be turned in and approved by a league director, with the coach present, before the first game of the season. Furthermore, any open team wishing to add a player before the fifth game deadline must get prior approval from a league director. <b>IMPORTANT NOTE: A player playing in a league game that is found to be ineligible may cause the team to forfeit any game in which he played.</b> This policy will be the same throughout all of the open and house leagues, including youth &amp; adult. At the discretion of TRH and at any time during the season, TRH reserves the right to verify rosters without notice. Please make sure all adult players carry a picture ID at all times. All youth teams must have a completed roster with jersey numbers turned in to TRH before playing their first game. Also, TRH will require every player that is on a roster to have a 'player ID and waiver' submitted prior to playing in their first game.</p>

<p><b>BANTAM / JUNIOR</b> (18 &amp; UNDER)</p>	
<p><b>ADULT 30</b> (COMPETATIVE &amp; ELITE)</p>	<p>Players must have their 30<sup>th</sup> birthday in 2010. Elite for the self-forming top teams, and competitive for the self-forming competitive team.</p>
<p><b>TIN</b></p>	<p>For beginners only. This league is designed for the player who just recently started playing hockey and has no competitive hockey experience. No players under 18 years of age will be allowed in this league. At TRH's discretion, players may be deemed ineligible for this league at any time during the season. "Lower-tiered"* Copper players <b>may</b> be allowed to play in this league with prior approval from a league director. Players playing in any other Adult league with the exception of 30+ Competitive are ineligible.</p>
<p><b>IRON</b></p>	<p>For beginners only. This league is designed for the player who just recently started playing hockey and has no competitive hockey experience. No players under 18 years of age will be allowed in this league. At TRH's discretion, players may be deemed ineligible for this league at any time during the season.</p>
<p><b>COPPER</b></p>	<p>This league is designed for the player who just recently started playing hockey and has no competitive hockey experience. Only two players under 18 years of age, and no players under 18 years of age will be allowed in this league, without prior consent from TRH director. At TRH's discretion, players may be deemed ineligible for this league at any time during the season</p>
<p><b>BRONZE</b></p>	<p>For inexperienced teams only. Silver players <b>may</b> be allowed to play in this league with prior approval from a league director. GOLD players will be allowed to play in this league (current or previous season) with approval. All players must be at least 18 years of age unless prior approval obtained from TRH. <i>Most new teams with little competitive experience should register in Copper.</i></p>
<p><b>SILVER/GOLD</b></p>	<p>For competitive teams with experience. All players must be at least 17 years of age unless prior approval obtained from TRH. At the TRH's discretion, players may be deemed ineligible for this league at any time during the season</p>

**NOTE:**

- 1) All ages based on player's age as of **December 31, 2009**.
- 2) TRH reserves the right to place teams in divisions at its sole discretion.
- 3) **All player classifications will be at the sole discretion of the TRH.**
- 4) Any team which wins a division two seasons in a row must move up to the next highest division. Additionally, any team, which finishes in the upper 20% of the league, may be asked to move up in leagues as well. Any team that is forced to move up but decides to stay down may have the following sanctions put on them:
  - A) The team must drop 51% of their roster from the previous season.
  - B) The team must drop 2 of its' top 3 scorer's from the previous season.
  - C) The team must have all roster additions approved by TRH.

TRH will only reschedule league games that conflict with an **APPROVED, TRH RECOGNIZED, INLINE HOCKEY TOURNAMENTS**. TRH requests a minimum ten days **written** notice of conflicting games. Additionally, TRH requires **written proof** that the team requesting the rescheduled game(s) has actually registered for the tournament; AND has specifically requested their tournament games to not conflict with our regular season league game.

<b>POLICIES &amp; PROCEDURES</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● First game schedule will be posted at the Total Roller Hockey web site on Tuesday Sept 14<sup>TH</sup>, after 6:00 PM. <b>All information can be obtained at the TRH website at <a href="http://www.totalrollerhockey.com">www.totalrollerhockey.com</a>, no phone calls regarding schedules will be accepted or returned.</b></li> <li>● If a team becomes delinquent in their fees, they may be forced to forfeit any games until the delinquency is satisfied. <b>(In order to avoid problems, it is suggested to pay entire fee at registration.)</b></li> <li>● All open league teams will be required to have matching jerseys with permanent numbers. <b>The home team must wear light colored jerseys and the away team must wear dark colored jerseys.</b></li> <li>● All open league teams subject to "SPECIAL OPEN LEAGUE RULES" available at the TRH office.</li> <li>● HECC approved helmets are mandatory, <b>NO EXCEPTIONS!</b></li> </ul>

*In order to complete your registration, the following will be required:*

<b>REQUIRED</b>	♦ Minimum \$300.00 payment in the form of CASH, VISA, <b>SINGLE-CHECK</b> or MONEY ORDER from the team captain. <b>MULTIPLE CHECKS MAY NOT BE ACCEPTED. ALL RETURNED CHECKS WILL BE SUBJECT TO A \$50.00 FEE.</b>
	♦ <b>A completed open league registration packet for all open league teams is due by Sept 13<sup>th</sup>, 2010.</b> This packet must include the waiver/roster signature page completely filled out for each player on the roster. All late waiver/roster signature pages or copies of a driver's license for each player will be subject to a late fee of \$5.00. Players under 18 years of age without a driver's license will need a copy of a birth certificate and a recent photo. Any player missing any of the above information and found to be playing will be considered an "illegal player", and all applicable forfeits and suspensions will be enforced.
	♦ The team captain acknowledging he has read and is aware of all TRH policies must return a signed "SPECIAL OPEN LEAGUE RULES" sheet.

<b>SPECIAL OPEN LEAGUE RULES</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. <b>All teams will shake hands when the game ends.</b> Any penalties will be enforced to the fullest extent.</li> <li>2. <b>No Fighting-</b> player may receive an automatic league suspension without refund. In the playoffs, any fighting majors will be subject to a minimum 5 game suspensions.</li> <li>3. TRH will be the governing body on deciding what constitutes a FIGHT</li> <li>4. Any player receiving 3 minor (2 min.) penalties in one game could receive a game misconduct or game ejection penalty. A game ejection penalty carries no additional game suspension; however, it does accumulate as a 10-minute misconduct.</li> <li>5. Any player receiving a major (5 min.) penalty – misconduct. The Referee reserves the right to issue a game ejection, game misconduct, or match penalty.</li> <li>6. MISCONDUCTS <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Any player receiving a game misconduct will miss the remainder of that game and the next full game scheduled for his team.</li> <li>• Any player receiving a second game misconduct during the same season will miss the remainder of that game and the next two- (2) full games scheduled for his team.</li> <li>• Any player receiving a third game misconduct during the season will automatically be suspended for the remainder of the season including playoffs. This suspension will total a minimum of three (3) games. <i>Any suspension not served during a season will automatically carry over into the next season, if applicable.</i></li> <li>• Any player accumulating two 10-minute misconducts will be credited with a game misconduct, AND SUSPENDED.</li> </ul> </li> <li>7. Any player receiving a season or indefinite suspension, TRH reserves the right, at its' discretion, to suspend the player for all leagues that player participates in for that season or longer.</li> <li>8. <b>All appeals or protests of suspensions must be in writing. A \$50.00 money order or cashiers check must accompany each appeal or protest.</b></li> <li>9. All teams are responsible for the conduct of their spectators. In the event a spectator becomes disruptive during a game, penalties can and will be assessed against the specific spectator's team.</li> <li>10. <b>GAMES WILL CONSIST OF (3) – 14 MINUTE RUNNING CLOCK PERIODS.</b></li> <li>11. During the regular season, tie games will stand. During the playoffs, tie games will be decided by a 5-minute running clock sudden death, and if still tied, a one round shoot-out, followed by a sudden death shoot-out.</li> <li>12. <b>Games may start up to 15 minutes prior to scheduled time of game.</b></li> <li>13. Each team will be allowed 1- 45-second time-out per game. No time-outs will be allowed during the last two- (2) minutes of a game unless the score is within two (2) goals. A (2) minute delay of game penalty can be issued if a time-out is called not meeting these criteria.</li> <li>14. <b>No refunds will be issued to players suspended or thrown out of any game or league.</b></li> <li>15. The maximum roster limit is fifteen (15) players, including goalies. All players on the original roster must sign the waiver/ roster signature page and submit a photocopy of their driver's license prior to play. Once a player plays in a game, he uses a roster spot. Rosters will be "frozen" after the start of the 5th game of the regular season. No additions or deletions can be made after that time. No non-roster skaters will be allowed at anytime. If a non-roster or "illegal" player is found to be playing, the team will automatically forfeit that game, and the team captain will be suspended for that team's next game.</li> <li>16. TRH reserves the right to verify rosters at any time at its discretion and without notice. Please make sure all players carry a picture ID at all times.</li> <li>17. <b>No player may play on more than one (1) team in the same league or age division. (EXCEPT HOUSE AND OPEN)</b></li> <li>18. A two (2) minute penalty will be assessed against any player intentionally diving in an effort to draw a penalty.</li> <li>19. <b>Any player deemed to be under the influence of alcohol as determined by TRH personnel shall be immediately ejected from any game, and subject to more suspensions.</b></li> <li>20. Should a team forfeit (2) two games during the same season, TRH has the option of forfeiting that team out of the league with no refund of any paid registration fees. Should a team forfeit a playoff game, that team may be required to automatically move up a division the next season played.</li> <li>21. Ten Goal Mercy Rule- Once a 10-goal differential is reached, the game will automatically be over. At that point, the teams <u>may</u> be allowed to scrimmage, or practice on their half of the floor for the remainder of the game time running clock. <b>If time can be made up by TRH, it shall do so at their discretion.</b></li> <li>22. TRH reserves the right to forfeit any game in which any team becomes delinquent in payment.</li> <li>23. TRH reserves the right to end any game in which they feel is getting out of hand, physically, without rescheduling.</li> </ol>
